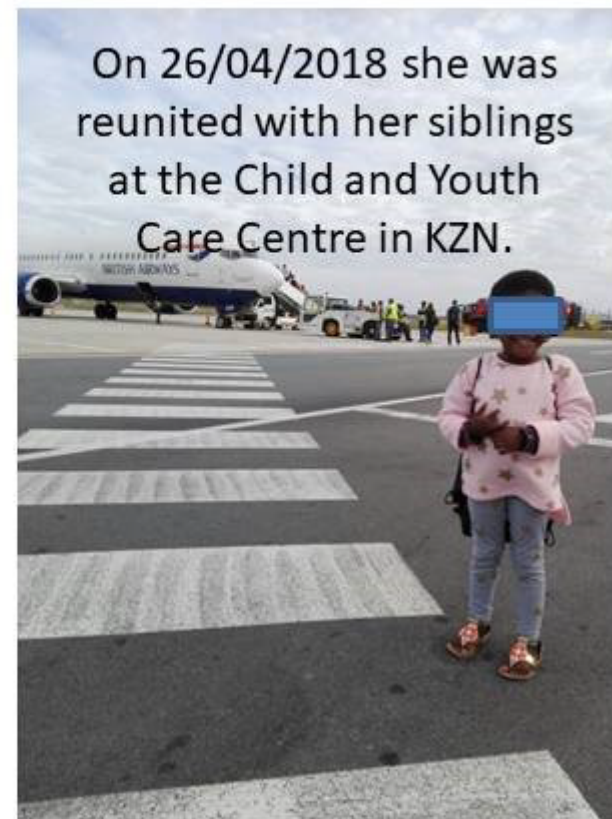
The **story** of a 4 year old girl, is confirmation of this.

On 20/02/2018 she came to my attention after she was found to be living on the street in unsafe conditions. A statutory investigation was inevitable – never an easy task! The reality of her situation was that she had no suitable family members to consider as possible foster parents; she has developmental delays as a result of her previous living conditions making it difficult to find a foster family willing to take on the responsibility of her care; The C&YCC in PE and surrounding areas did not have an opening for her. Thankfully God answered prayers and answered the mess of her life with one word: **“grace.”**

- Her 3 sisters were traced and found to be living at a Child and Youth Care Centre in KZN.
- The social worker at the C&YCC, without having to ask, offered a placement for her
- Assessment by a physical therapist as well as an occupational therapist, at no cost to the CMR, thanks to the tremendous support / assistance of the Safe Haven Project Manager
- The obstacle to get the necessary approval and willingness of an organisation to accept statutory supervision was overcome.
- Transport to the C&YCC through donations
