Foster care provides a temporary placement / home for children in need of care.



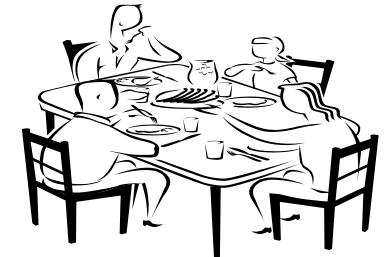
It is a legal form of alternative parenting.

- + an opportunity to develop to their full potential, both emotionally and physically.



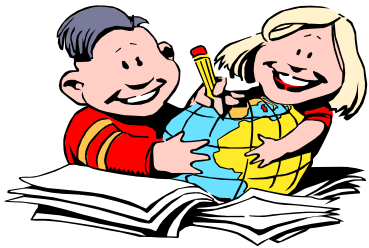
It allows you the opportunity to make a difference in the life of a child.

Your application will provide us with background information regarding yourself and your family.

Information from your employer and references will be required.



You will then undergo a screening process, before a placement could be done.

WHO TO FOSTER?

Children between the ages of 0-17 years are constantly in need of care.

These children could be abused, neglected, abandoned or orphaned.
